CERTIFICATION OF INSURANCE/PUBLICITY INFORMATION

This application and all fees should be received at the PATU office at least 30 days prior to the start of event. Allow 5 business days for processing. Commercial General Liability Insurance is required and need to include the following as additional insureds: Pan American Taekwondo Union, and the members, officers, directors, agents and employees of each entity with minimum liability coverage of \$2,000.000.00 for events in U.S. & Canada and \$500,000.00 for remaining Pan American regions.



TOURNAMENT SANCTION & SEMINAR/EVENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must follow current WTF & PATU Rules and regulations.
- Invite one PATU Tournament Technical Delegate/PATU Seminar Instructor:
 - A) Provision of roundtrip air tickets and free accommodation of room and board from at least 24 hours before the event through one (1) day after the tournament/seminar.
 - B) Daily allowance of US\$300 for the duration of the competition/seminar.
 - C) Designation of a car for use of Technical Delegate/Instructor and any other PATU officials or staff.
- Invite one Tournament Assistant to PATU Technical Delegate if there are more than 500 competitors for tournament.
- Invite one Seminar Assistant to PATU Seminar Instructor if there are more than 50 seminar or certification participants.
 - A) Provision of roundtrip air tickets and free accommodation of room and board for one (1) PATU official or staff from to assist Technical Delegate/seminar instructor at least one (1) day before through one (1) day after the tournament/seminar.
 - B) Daily allowance of US\$200 for the duration of the competition.

*Technical Delegate & Seminar Instructor shall be appointed by the PATU President. The major roles of Technical Delegate are to supervise technical matters in general and resolve any technical issues pertaining to the tournament and also evaluate the tournament for grading of the event.

*PATU will support developing countries with sponsorships and grants. Please email uswc@hotmail.com with completed application.

- Medical Requirements: One Medical Doctor or ALS (Advance Life Support) equipped paramedics unit is required for all tournaments. A copy of the medical doctor's license or ALS order must be sent to PATU office 10 days prior to the event.
- All participants MUST Sign Liability Waiver.

If documentation is not submitted within the timeframe established a \$500 penalty fee will apply or the sanction will be canceled.

Championship Sanction Fee:

International Championships - \$5000.00 Local/Regional Championships - \$2500.00

Camp Sanction Fee:

PATU World Class Athlete Development Camp - \$2500.00 Local/Regional Camp Sanction Fee - \$1500.00

WTF Poomsae/Kyorugi Seminar Fee:

Host need to provide round trip air ticket for seminar instructor, meals and lodging. Minimum 30 participants required. PATU Poomsae & Kyorugi Seminar is \$100.00 per person. Host may charge up to an additional \$25 per participant to help cover the cost of hosting.

PATU Poomsae or Kyorugi Referee Certification Course Fee:

Host need to provide round trip air ticket for seminar instructor, meals and lodging. Minimum 30 participants required. PATU Poomsae or Kyorugi Referee certification is \$200.00 per person. Host may charge up to an additional \$30 per participant to help cover the cost of hosting.
